Community Representatives are the grass roots level community activists representing AkiDwa and raising awareness about FGM in their own communities.

These community representatives can campaign locally and approach professionals such as GPs and teachers and supply them with information and materials about FGM to make them aware of the issue and how they should deal with it in their specific areas of work.

AkiDwa is a partner of the END FGM European Campaign which is run by Amnesty International Ireland. The campaign aims to ensure that the European Union delivers a definitive strategy to prevent young girls and women in Europe from being mutilated and to protect those who flee their countries for fear of being mutilated.
